Year 11 Final examinations and leavers dates

I am writing to you regarding our Year 11 students completing their final exams and leaving Scalby School.

The final whole year group examination is Physics on Friday 16th June. On this day there is also Geography and then finally Food Preparation and further Maths for some students on Wednesday 21st June.

We therefore plan to have a leavers assembly and celebration late in the afternoon on Thursday 15th June. This will involve a short assembly, some refreshments, and the chance to sign shirts, speak to teachers and sign leavers books.
