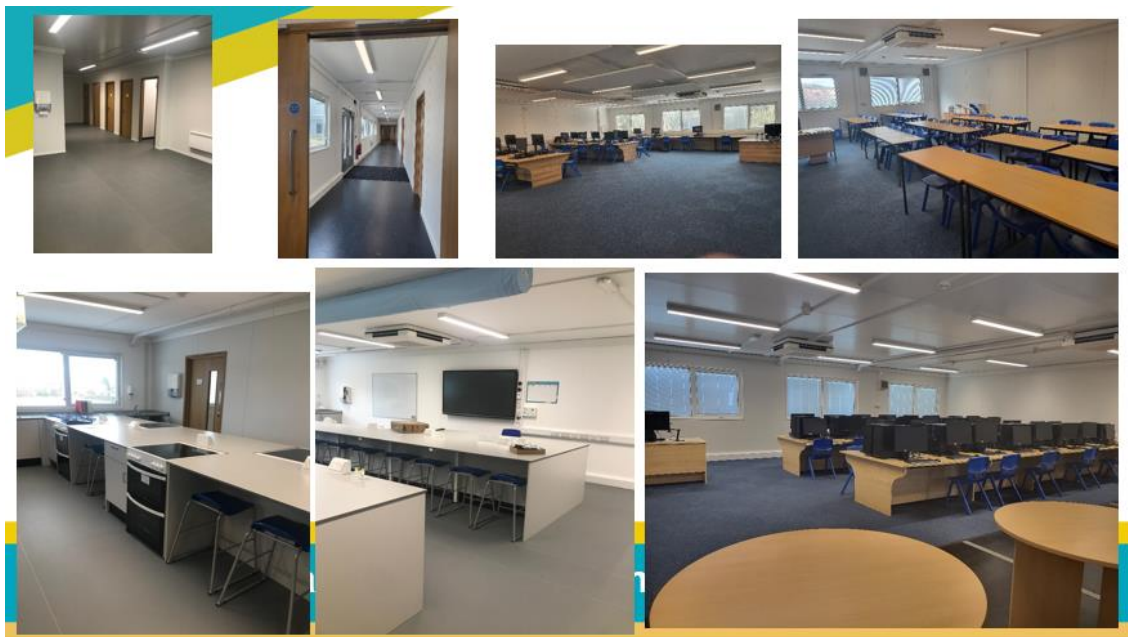
Building Update
