#### Examinations

The Year 11's continue to work incredibly hard through their GCSE exams, with only 2 more full days left at school! Many thanks to the staff and students who attended the revision sessions in the May half term. After speaking to a few of the students, they have said that they really appreciated the extra support and have felt more prepared for their exams.

#### **Building Work**

Next week we will begin building an extension onto our current dining facility, this will mean there will no longer be the need for the marquees from September. Over the Summer holidays further work will be undertaken to remodel the playground area of the school. These works are expected to be complete for September.

#### **Re-building Programme**

Before the holidays it was confirmed that the school is a priority 1 school on the rebuilding programme. The Trust is currently working with North Yorkshire County Council to secure a new site for the school. Further information will be provided when agreements have been reached.

#### Year 10 - Trial Examinations

We appreciate that this may have caused some slight disruption, but we have made these changes to align with the collaboration with Delta and we believe this will be for the benefit of our students. learnt about the different types of personality and how these affect sporting performances and Biomechanics in which students learnt about the 3 Laws of motion and worked as a team to create a working model car.


#### Training Day update
