Delta Academies Trust

The last few weeks have seen us working closely as a School and Trust with Delta Academies Trust, Education Exchange programme under the leadership of our new CEO Paul Tarn. The Education Exchange is currently providing support to Scalby School and all the schools across the Trust to ensure that outcomes for young people are excellent and sustainable in the coastal region. As a school this support is allowing us to review our curriculums, systems and processes. This will only lead to further improvements in the educational offer and experiences we can provide to students at Scalby School.

As a result of reviewing our curriculum and systems we will not be rolling the timetable over early next month. This will allow us to plan curriculum drop down days with Year 10 students in preparation for them stepping up to Year 11. We are also transitioning Year 7 students back into other parts of the school over remaining weeks of term and planning some curriculum drop down days for them in the Autumn term.
